About Yumi C.A.R.E.S.

The vision for this pioneering program — the first of its kind in the state of Maryland — was initially conceived by First Lady Yumi Hogan during the time she spent with her family at the University of Maryland Medical Center.

Led by a trained art therapist, the Art Therapy Program fosters a sense of empowerment and strength in children ages 1 to 21 facing health challenges, helping them heal both emotionally and physically. Through their experience in the program, the children build resiliency and coping skills, work through depression, and manage pain and anxiety. When given a chance to express themselves in this way, pediatric patients gain a sense of control at a time when they feel they have none.

Since October of 2018, hundreds of individual patients have participated in art therapy at University of Maryland Children's Hospital. Our goal is to expand the program to partner with hospitals across Maryland.
